Specific Aims

- General Waste
 - Reduce general waste wherever possible through careful purchasing
 - Sort and send all general waste (Glass; Plastics; Food Waste) to a zero landfill destination
- Paper & Packaging
 - Reduce paper waste from office activities through elimination and recycling
 - Reduce packaging waste through recycling and re-use
 - Reduce wood waste through recycling of pallets
- Material Waste
 - Reduce Steel; Stainless Steel & Aluminium waste through efficient material usage
 - Sort our Steel; Stainless Steel & Aluminium waste to allow effective recycling
 - Recycle any waste lubricants or cleaning fluids
- Energy Waste
 - Reduce our electricity consumption through use of energy efficient devices; turning off items when not in use
 - Reduce our gas consumption through use of energy efficient devices; turning off items when not in use; control of heating settings; maximising oven fills when powder coating
 - Reduce our water consumption through use of energy efficient devices and smart technologies
 - Consider energy efficiency when purchasing new items of equipment
